Short Facts — Marulan NSW 2579

- Marulan is a town in the Goulburn Mulwaree Council area in New South Wales.
- It lies on the **150th meridian east** the only town in the world on that line of longitude which means at the equinox, sunrise and sunset align very closely with 6:00 am / 6:00 pm local time.
- The town was relocated about 3 km north in the 1860s when the Main Southern railway line opened.
- Marulan railway station opened on **6 August 1868** on the Main Southern line.
- It has heritage significance, including the site of **Old Marulan Town**, which reflects the earlier township before relocation.
- The population is modest in the 2021 Census, Marulan had about **1,178** residents.
- The median age is around **41 years**.
- Land use in Marulan is predominantly rural: large proportions are zoned rural landscape, environmental conservation, and primary production.
- The main street and village area include amenities like cafés, a pub, pharmacy, bakery, IGA, boutique shops and rural suppliers.
