- Towrang is a small village in the New South Wales Southern Tablelands, part of Goulburn Mulwaree Council.
- It lies about 13 km north of Goulburn, and roughly 180 km south of Sydney.
- The elevation is about **629 metres** above sea level.
- At the 2016 census, Towrang had a population of **171 people**.
- Historically, Towrang was an important convict-worksite region. The **Towrang Convict Stockade**, bridge, culverts, powder magazine and grave sites remain as heritage elements near the Wollondilly River and the old Great South Road alignment. The stockade was active roughly between 1836 and 1842, and during its operation it held a large number of convicts working on road construction.
- The area was once a significant fruit-producing region supplying Sydney markets.
- Towrang is bounded by nearby localities such as Greenwich Park (north), Carrick (east), and Boxers Creek (south & southeast).
- The **Parish of Towrang** (in the cadastral sense) lies in County Argyle. The Wollondilly River forms part of its boundary, and the Hume Highway and Southern Highlands railway pass through parts of it.
